Supplemental Budget HB 5056/SB 2556

*Supplemental budget bills are created separately by the House and Senate. They may or may not have identical sections in each version. Each bill and its amendments are passed by either the House or Senate but are not yet law. Both bills are then sent to a conference committee which consists of three members from the House and three members from the Senate. In the conference committee, they consider conflicting sections and they may add, alter or delete existing sections but may not add entirely new sections. When the reconciled bills are released as a single bill, each side of the legislature can give it only an up or down vote to pass it to the Governor's desk. It is then sent to the Governor's office for his signature to pass it into law. He may veto single or multiple sections or provisions of the bill. Upon his veto, those sections are returned to the House, which must decide to take them up or not. If the House does take up a veto, it requires a 2/3rds vote to override the Governor's veto. If successful, it passes to the Senate, which must also have a 2/3rds vote to pass the veto. If a bill overcomes the veto, it becomes law.
