Harbor Protection Feasibility Study

Researchers at the University of Massachusetts Boston are part of a multi-disciplinary team that is evaluating the feasibility of several options for protecting Boston Harbor from storm surge, including an engineered barrier providing harbor-wide protection. An important element of the study is to ensure that the designs are informed by the views of harbor users, such as recreational boaters, as to how such protection options might affect their use of the harbor and bay. We are hoping to meet with Boston Harbor marina managers, yacht club representatives or others knowledgeable about recreation boating use of the harbor to present concepts and elicit feedback and comments.
